ACADEMICS

- BVM Sec 39 really feels very proud and privileged to announce CBSE BOARD results of class X and XII (2021-22). This year too our students once again brought laurels to our school by achieving 100% results. As per our tradition, the students of class X, who appeared for Secondary School Examination conducted by CBSE for the session 2021-22, passed with flying colours. Out of 102 students 6 students scored above 90%, 21 students above 80% and 16 students scored above 70%. Riya bagged the FIRST POSITION with 93% marks. Second POSITION was won by Ridhi Mahajan with 92.6%. Parkriti and Saloni Dhamija stood THIRD with 91.8% marks each. Students of class XII also proved their mettle and excelled in the CBSE Board Exams. In all, 119 students appeared in 4 streams (MEDICAL, NON MEDICAL, COMMERCE AND HUMANITIES). Out of 16 students of Medical stream, *3 students jout of 39 students of Non Medical stream *9 students*; and out of 52 students of Commerce stream *10 students*; out of 12 students of Humanities *2* students scored above *80%.* It gives us immense pleasure to announce the names of our bright students.
- * In Medical stream *Sneha Bansal (93%) stood FIRST, Shruti Khera(85%) gained SECOND POSITION and Khushi with 82.2% got THIRD POSITION.*
