ACADEMICS

BVM Sector-39 is heading towards the higher levels of accomplishments in a very commendable manner. We proudly announce the result of classes X and XII (2022-23).

Excellence in class 10th results has always filled us with pride and we feel honoured to announce that our students once again proved their mettle by achieving **100% results**.

- Out of 106 students, 10 students scored above 90%, 32 students above 80% and 27 students scored above 70%.
- Ashutosh Chandra clinched **First Position** with 96.6%
- Dev Shah secured **Second Position** with 96.2%
- Simarpreet Kaur gained **Third Position** with 93.2%

Continuing the celebration of success, students of class XII of 4 streams (Commerce, Medical, Non-Medical Medical and Humanities) came out with flying colours.

- Out of 8 students of Medical stream 1 student, out of 50 students of Commerce stream 5 students and out of 23 students of Humanities 2 students scored above 90%.
- Growth in academics is a result of the multiple opportunities provided in school for up gradation of skills and knowledge. It gives us immense pleasure to announce the names of our bright gems of class XII.
- In Commerce stream, Jashan Kapoor bagged **First Position** with 93.2% marks. **Second position** was won by Bhaghya Nayyar with 93%. Shivanahu Thakur secured **Third Position** with 92.6% marks each.
- In Humanities stream, **Khyati Verma with 92.6%, Shagun with 89.6%, Khushi Kunwar with 80%** won **First, Second and Third** respectively.
- In Medical stream, **Jaidev Lehal with 91.2%** stood **FIRST**, **Anshika Singh and Sumit Gupta** both shared **SECOND POSITION** by gaining 83.6% and **Deepanshu** with 75.8% got **THIRD POSITION**.
- In Non-Medical stream, **Dinesh Sharma(88.4%), Deepanshi(87.8%), Inderjeet Singh Sandhu(81.2%)** secured **FIRST, SECOND and THIRD** positions respectively.

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SEMINARS FOR TEACHERS
